Fourth Quarter Report

The LTBB Housing Commission consists of Chairperson Patrick Wemigwase, Secretary Annette VanDeCar and Commissioners Larry Stead and Judith Pierzynowski.

The commission held a regular meeting on November 2, 2018.

At the November 2, 2018 meeting, the commission reviewed the information and handouts received from Secretary Annette VanDeCar, who attended the Tribal Council Presentation on the Second Street and Monroe Street properties held on October 23, 2018. The commission held a discussion regarding the building of tiny homes on tribal properties and will further research this topic. The commission requested the Housing Department send letters to all residents reminding them not to dump furniture, tires, mattresses, etc. near the dumpster. Residents are to dispose of these themselves. This continues to be a problem currently. The commission also discussed plans to host a Housing Commission Holiday Potluck in December 2018.

Old business included the proposal to bring Internet service to Wah Wahs No De Kee Housing, which Tribal Council has never taken any action on, and to collaborate with the Housing Department to host an informational meeting/workshop in regards to home ownership on tribal land in the spring.
