Request for Funding from the U.S. Department of Justice
FY 2013 Adult Drug Court Discretionary Grant Program

WHEREAS the Waganakising Odawak, known in English as Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a nation of citizens with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance and;

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians ("LTBB") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Band of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected legislative body of the Tribe;

WHEREAS the Tribal Government includes a justice system consisting of the Tribal Court as one of the three branches of Tribal Government, and;

WHEREAS the mission of the Tribal Court is to implement the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians judicial system, consistent with self-determination and the sovereign powers of the Tribe, by building on the community values of respect, culture and spirituality, that allows for unity, fairness and due process in resolving issues, conflicts and disputes within the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians' jurisdiction, and;

WHEREAS the U.S. Department of Justice has announced funding availability for the Adult Court Discretionary Grant Program that support activities designed to develop and implement drug courts that effectively integrate evidenced-based substance abuse treatment, mandatory drug testing, sanctions and incentives, and transitional services in a judicially supervised court setting.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Band of Odawa Indians authorizes and supports this request for funding from the United States Department of Justice for the FY 2013 LTBB Adult Drug Court Discretionary Grant Program.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the LTBB Tribal Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, Tribal Administrator, or another designee from the Tribal Chairperson is authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for, receive, and administer funds under the grant.
