

Request for Funding from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency,
Under Section 103 of the Clean Air Act,
FY 2015 Region 5 Tribal Air Grants,
Clean Air Program

- WHEREAS the Waganakising Odawak, known in English as Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a nation of citizens with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance and;
- whereas the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians ("LTBB") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);
- **WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected legislative body of the Tribe;
- **WHEREAS** the Tribe's treaty delineated reservation area encompasses approximately 336 square miles in Northwestern-Lower Michigan;
- WHEREAS the LTBB relies on environmental protection (including air quality) for the health of Tribal members and cultural perpetuation and this continues to be threatened by the ever increasing popularity of the area both as a tourist/resort area or relocation for permanent residence within the reservation area;
- where the United States Environmental Protection Agency has approved funding availability for an air quality program that is consistent with the mission of the Tribe's Natural Resource Department Environmental Services Program to address air quality within the reservation and airshed through evaluation of the LTBB emissions inventory, implementation of strategies to monitor and reduce identified pollution sources, and community education and outreach.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes and supports this request for funding from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for a 24-month LTBB Clean Air Act Program.
