**LITIGATION SUPPORT FUNDS**

**WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians desires Litigation Support Funds from the Bureau of Indian Affairs for funds to research, document, and protect the Tribe's interest in matters that will soon arise regarding the Tribe's reservation boundaries, due to events which ensued following the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855;

**WHEREAS** the Tribal Council reviewed and approved a Litigation Support Request at this meeting on September 8, 1996;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Little Traverse Bay Bands requests to contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs under the authority of Public Law 93-638, as amended, for litigation support funds for fiscal year 1997 and designates Tribal Chairman Frank Ettawageshik to execute such contract.

**Transportation Improvement Program Funding**

- WHEREAS: The Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians of Michigan is a federally recognized tribe, as reaffirmed under P.L. 103-324, enacted September 21, 1994 and
- WHEREAS: The tribe and its members are eligible for all services and benefits by the Federal Government to Indians, and
- WHEREAS: The Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians desires to improve the road system serving the Reservation community, and
- WHEREAS: The Bureau of Indian Affairs Branch of Roads is providing Transportation Planning Contract funds, and
- WHEREAS: The Tribal Planning Department is engaged in transportation planning activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Little Traverse Bay Bands is requesting funding from the Bureau of Indian Affairs under a 638 Contract in the amount of \$5,000.00 to assist the Tribal Planning Department in its transportation planning activities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Tribal Chairman or in his absence the Tribal Administrator be empowered with the authority to negotiate and execute a contract between the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the Little Traverse Bay Bands.

**Certification**
