WHEREAS : the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians (L.T.B.B.) of Michigan is a federally recognized Tribe, as reaffirmed under P.L. 103-324, and enacted September 21, 1994, and

WHEREAS : the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians places a high priority on the well-being of the tribal Elder's of the Little Traverse Bay Bands, and

WHEREAS : the Title VI Grants for Native Americans provides for programming dollars for the Elder's of the Native Community, and

WHEREAS : the Little Traverse Bay Bands Elder's Program is making application to the Dept. Of Health & Human Services for Title VI funding for an Elder's Program in the amount of sixty four thousand eight hundred and eighty dollars (\$64,880.00); and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that all certifications and assurances that are required for funding through DHHS, have been signed and attached herewith, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands through it's Tribal Chairman Frank Ettawageshik submits the FY'99 Title VI Grants to the Department of Health & Human Services.
