**Approval of FY 2003 Tribal Transportation Improvement Program**

- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a federally recognized Indian tribe, as reaffirmed under Public Law 103-324, enacted September 21, 1994;
- WHEREAS** the Tribe wishes to ensure the future of the local transportation system for the benefit of its members;
- WHEREAS** the Tribal Council has determined that there is a need for road improvements within the Reservation area;
- WHEREAS** there are funds available through the Bureau of Indian Affairs for a program of services which will meet those needs as identified annually by the Tribal Council;
- WHEREAS** the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Indian Reservation Roads Program has provided the Tribe with an opportunity to indicate its Transportation Project Priorities for the period 2003 to 2006;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council approves the priorities and projects as indicated in the FY 2003 Tribal Transportation Improvement Program.
