## TRIBAL RESOLUTION # 102220- ()

Appropriations of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act") in the amount of \$1,111,279.40

- WHEREAS the Waganakising Odawak Nation, known as the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, and its citizens are vested with inherent sovereignty and rights of self-governance;
- WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States, the most recent of which are the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);
- WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is governed by a Tribal Constitution adopted by the citizens of the Tribe on February 1, 2005;
- WHEREAS Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians received additional funding under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act") 3rd installment in the amount of \$1,111,279.40 to be used within the guidelines provided by the U.S. Department of Treasury;
- WHEREAS Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act") funds may be used by the Tribe for public health needs, as well as expenditures incurred to respond to effects of the emergency, such as business interruptions due to COVID-19-related business closures;
- WHEREAS in accordance with the U.S. Department of Treasury guidelines, the Tribe allocates the funds to the following service area:
  - 54% to LTBB Government offices expenses related to COVID-19 for building closure;
  - 36% to COVID 19 Safety upgrades for programs and buildings;

### 10% to COVID 19 Citizen Response.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribe authorizes and approves funding to the Executive Branch in the amount of \$1,111,279.40 as follows: 54% to LTBB Government offices expenses related to COVID-19 for building closure; 36% to COVID-19 Safety upgrades for programs and buildings; and 10% to COVID-19 Citizens' Response during the COVID-19 Pandemic.

FINALLY, BE IT RESOLVED that in accordance with the Constitution the Executive Branch shall administer such funds as appropriated by Tribal Council.
