CONTINUATION AND EXTENSION OF FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN

THE LITTLE TRAVERSE BAY BANDS OF ODAWA INDIANS AND BEAR CREEK AND RESORT TOWNSHIPS

- 1. The Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians ("LTBB" or "Tribe"), Bear Creek Township ("Bear Creek") and Resort Township ("Resort") (Bear Creek and Resort collectively referred to as the "Townships") are parties to a Fire Protection Services Agreement
- 2. Section 18 of the Agreement provided that it would expire five years from its effective date unless terminated pursuant to the Agreement or otherwise extended in writing by further agreement of the parties.
- 3. The parties have not terminated the Agreement nor agreed to a written continuation and extension of the Agreement, but have informally continued under the terms of the Agreement since January 1, 2016.
- 4. The parties hereby ratify their actions pursuant to the Agreement since January 1, 2016.
- 5. Section 18 of the Agreement is amended to read:

("Agreement") with an effective date of January 1, 2011.

- 18. Termination. This Agreement is continued and extended on a year-to-year basis beginning as of January 1, 2018, although either Party may terminate this Agreement immediately for cause or upon written advance notice of one year in any other instance. The termination of this Agreement shall not eliminate LTBB's obligation for payment of any runs incurred prior to termination or of any other financial obligation incurred prior to termination.
- 6. Updated legal descriptions of the LTBB properties within the Townships and the status of these properties are attached as **Exhibit A**.
- 7. Except as amended by this Continuation and Extension, the provisions of the Agreement shall remain the same as originally approved by the parties.

The undersigned execute this Continuation and Extension as duly authorized representatives of the respective parties.
