## PARENTAL RIGHTS DEFINED

Parental rights include, but are not limited to the following:

- 1. The right to know and associate with the child.
- 2. Care, custody, maintenance, health and protection. A child has a right to call upon the parent to exercise these duties;
- 3. **Advise the child.** Law presumes that advice is given in good faith and in the best interest of the child;
- 4. **Right to discipline.** Parents may use discipline that is reasonable;
- 5. **Control of education.** Parents may choose where the child attends school;
- 6. **Religious training.** The religious training of the child, or lack of it, is a matter solely within the parent's control;
- 7. **The right to a child's services and earnings.** Parents have the fiduciary responsibility to act in good faith and in the best interest of the child; and
- 8. The right to direct the child's activities and make decisions regarding the child's care and control, education, health and religion.
