The Court conducted a *Plea Hearing* on Thursday, January 05, 2006. The Respondent and LTBB Conservation Department were present, along with the Tribal Presenting Officer participating by phone. The Court sought clarification of the potential penalty faced by Respondent. The Court's confusion was the result of the apparent use of the words "fine" and "restitution" interchangeably in the *Regulations*.

After clarification, Respondent was advised that the potential penalty for the charged civil infraction is two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00).
