#### FACTS

- 1. The respondent, Travis Fitch, was given a citation on June 23, 2006 for Failure to File a Catch Report for the month of May 2006
- On July 7, 2006, the Clerk of Court mailed the respondent a Plea by Mail form which indicated that respondent had fourteen (14) days to respond to the notice. Respondent could admit responsibility by using the Plea by Mail form or request a formal hearing before the Court.
- The respondent did not contact the Court to request a hearing nor did he use the Plea by Mail form.
- 4. The Court scheduled a Show Cause for failure to submit a Plea by Mail for December 7, 2006. Respondent did not appear in court for the hearing.
- The notice that was mailed stated if the respondent did not respond to the court within the fourteen (14) days that his fishing privileges would be immediately revoked.

### **ORDER**

Since respondent has not contacted the Court to resolve this matter, the court will immediately REVOKE your LTBB Natural Resources privileges and you will be required to contact the Court to attend to the matter pending before the court and for reinstatement of your LTBB Natural Resources privileges. Once privileges are revoked, they will not be reinstated until this matter is resolved

NOTICE: You may request that the Order Revoking Treaty Privileges be set aside if you can show good cause for your failure to enter a plea. The request must be filed within14 days of the mailing date indicated below and must be accompanied with an affidavit of facts showing a meritorious defense to the citation referenced above. The Court will schedule a hearing once the request is received.
