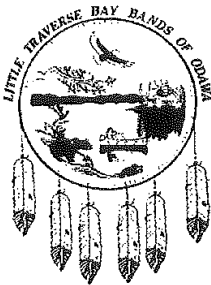

The Court finds that a Show Cause Hearing was held on September 29, 2009. The Respondent, Todd M. Munson, plead responsible by mail on August 14, 2009 for Failure to Submit Commercial Fisher Catch Report. The total amount due to the Court is \$100.00 (\$50.00 fine and \$50.00 court costs). Mr. Munson did not pay the \$100.00 and did not contact the Court to arrange payments. The Court was informed that Mr. Munson had a warrant for his arrest on another matter.

On October 19, 2009, the Court continued the Show Cause Hearing. Mr. Munson was present for the hearing and requested community service in lieu of paying the fine and court costs.

This Court did not find Mr. Munson in contempt of court and approved his request for community service in lieu of paying \$100.00. Community service hours are determined by taking the total amount due to the Court (\$100.00) and dividing that by the current minimum wage (\$7.25 an hour).

WHEREFORE, IT IS SO ORDERED that Mr. Munson will meet with the LTBB Probation Office on November 30, 2009 at 2:00 p.m. to schedule his 14 hours of community service. He will complete the community service by January 01, 2010.


