# WAKANAKISING ODAWAK STATUTE AMENDMENT TO WAGANAKISING ODAWAK STATUTE 2006-016 WETLANDS PROTECTION AND MANAGEMENT STATUTE

#### **SECTION I. INSERT:**

# SECTION X. NON-RETROACTIVE DEVELOPMENT RESTRICTIONS

The development restrictions in this Statute shall not apply to parcels of land owned in fee by LTBB or held in trust by the United States for the Tribe where LTBB acquired title prior to September 18, 2006, for the purpose of economic development as stated in a trust application submitted to the Department of the Interior, Tribal Council approved site plan, or other recorded action of Tribal Council.

### SECTION XI. MITIGATION FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Land that is acquired that is contigious to land that has been previously acquired prior to September 18, 2006, for economic development may be mitigated by a set aside of wetlands equal to or larger and such land shall be designated as wetlands.

## SECTION II. EFFECTIVE DATE

Effective upon signature of the Executive or 30 days from Tribal Council approval whichever comes first or if the Executive vetoes the Statute, then upon Tribal Council override of the veto.
