

**RESOLUTION #011700-01
LIQUOR CONTROL CODE ADOPTION**

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians seeks to promote the economic well-being of the Tribe and its members, while protecting Tribal members and all other persons within the Tribe’s jurisdiction by carefully regulating the sale, distribution and consumption of alcoholic beverages;

WHEREAS the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians has enacted a Liquor Control Statute for the regulation of alcoholic beverages and has the responsibility of issuance of Liquor Licenses to Tribal enterprises;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians shall assimilate for its use the State of Michigan Liquor Control Code of the Michigan Liquor Control Commission (attached to this resolution) for its use, in the interim, during the development of the LTBB Civil Codes.
