Request for Funding from Prevention Network
Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians
Youth Leadership Project

- WHEREAS** the Waganakising Odawak Nation, known as the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, and its citizens are vested with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance;
- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);
- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected legislative body of the Tribe;
- WHEREAS** the LTBB governmental services includes an Education Department that is committed to the vision that through education communities and families flourish;
- WHEREAS** the LTBB Education Department values knowledge, integrity, change and growth and strongly adheres to administering fair and accessible programs that are beneficial for Indian people – including children;
- WHEREAS** the Prevention Network Foundation has announced the availability of funding for programs that prevent substance abuse.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes and supports this request for funding from the Prevention Network Foundation for a 6-month youth leadership grant for the prevention of underage drinking.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Tribal Chairman Ken Harrington, Vice Chairman Dexter McNamara, Tribal Administrator Albert Colby Jr., or another designee from the Tribal Chairman is authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for, receive, and administer funds under the grant.
