WHEREAS : the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians (L.T.B.B.) of Michigan is a federally recognized Tribe, as reaffirmed under P.L. 103-324, and enacted September 21, 1994, and

WHEREAS : the Grand Traverse Band of Ottawa & Chippewa Indians, (GTB) through their Cultural representative, Jack Chambers, has requested support for their National Park Service (NPS) grant application which would protect Garden Island (Kaatigaaning) from the development that would disturb or destroy its cultural significance, and

WHEREAS : the L.T.B.B. recognizes the historical and cultural significance of Kaatigaaning to the Anishnaabek of the Great Lakes region, and the United States of the America, and

WHEREAS : Kaatigaaning is part of our reservation set aside by the 1855 Treaty at Detroit, and L.T.B.B. assumes responsibility for the management of its cultural resources, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the L.T.B.B. supports the GTB grant application to the NPS for FY'99 that would seek measures to provide protection to Kaatigaaning as a cultural resource, and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the L.T.B.B. Cultural and Historical Preservation Officer and the L.T.B.B. Tribal Council be involved with the development and approval of any cultural resource or other management plans or policies that may result from the activities associated with the National Park Service grant.
