**Resolution # 022000-01
Rural Rental Housing Loan Application**

Whereas The Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a Federally recognized Indian tribe as reaffirmed under Public Law 103-324 of September 21, 1994;

Whereas The Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians has a significant need for development of low income rental housing for tribal members;

Whereas the USDA Rural Development, Rural Rental Housing loan program provides funding for development of such housing at a subsidized interest rate;

Whereas part of the application package will also include an application for subsidization of the monthly rent for the 12 units;

Therefore it is resolved that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians supports an application package submitted to the United States Department of Agriculture, Rural Development for the purpose of funding 6 low rent duplex units for tribal elders to be built on the Heynig Road property, as well as a small elders center with kitchen facilities and gathering room and a small office space.

Further resolved that Tribal Chairman, Gerald V. Chingwa, or his successor Chairman is authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for and receive funds under the grant.
