RESOLUTION #022000-04 AUTHORIZATION FOR AMICUS BRIEF

WHEREAS the State of Michigan Ingham County Circuit Court, in *Taxpayers of Michigan, et al. v. State of Michigan, et al.* issued a declaratory judgment stating the LTBB's class III state/tribal compact, as well as the compacts for the Pokagon Band of Potawatomi Indians, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians and the Huron Band of Potawatomi Indians, were not properly approved under state law based on Judge Houk's finding that the compacts are legislative in nature;

WHEREAS LTBB was not a party to said case;

WHEREAS LTBB believes the decision is erroneous based in part of the court's lack of understanding of Indian law;

WHEREAS the State of Michigan and intervening parties have filed a claim of appeal in this case;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes its attorneys to file an amicus brief on its behalf in the Michigan Court of Appeals or Michigan Supreme Court to support overturning the decision of the Ingham County Circuit Court, especially apprizing the appellate courts of the Indian law issues that provide the backdrop to analysis of this case;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this amicus brief may be prepared and filed jointly with one or more of the other three effected tribes if LTBB's attorneys find it appropriate

to do so.
