THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians ardently supports the efforts of the Cass Lake-Bena High School Name Change Committee to eliminate the use of the term "squaw" from the names of places, facilities, and general use.
