WHEREAS,	we are saddened by the death of Ogichidaa Pfc. Lori Ann Piestewa,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council presents this Eagle Feather posthumously to Hopi Nation Ogichidaa Pfc. Lori Ann Piestewa, 507th Maintenance Company to honor her in death as one who has made the ultimate sacrifice for our liberties.
