Honoring Hopi Nation Ogichidaa Pfc. Lori Ann Piestewa, 507th Maintenance Company

- WHEREAS, the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621), and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is the duly elected governing body of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, and
- WHEREAS, Ogichidaa the word for our veterans means *she has a big heart*, we honor and thank the veterans who have fought for our liberties, and
- WHEREAS, an Eagle Feather is given to those who've accomplished deeds of selflessness and is one of the highest honors we can bestow upon such a person, and
- WHEREAS, Ogichidaa Pfc. Lori Ann Piestewa, 507th Maintenance Company of the Hopi Nation who died in combat is worthy of such an honor, and
- WHEREAS, we are saddened by the death of Ogichidaa Pfc. Lori Ann Piestewa,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council presents this Eagle Feather posthumously to Hopi Nation Ogichidaa Pfc. Lori Ann Piestewa, 507th Maintenance Company to honor her in death as one who has made the ultimate sacrifice for our liberties.
