## RESOLUTION 041600-01 NAGPRA REPRESENTATIVE

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians seeks to protect and promote its rights to control Tribal ancestral remains and artifacts, wherever they may be currently located;

WHEREAS under the Native American Graves and Repatriation Act (NAGPRA) Indian tribes have the right to recover their artifacts and ancestral remains that are held in any federally funded institution;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians (LTBB), a federally recognized Indian tribe, reaffirms its designation of Wesley L. Andrews as its official representative to pursue issues relative to NAGPRA on the Tribe's behalf. This authorization replaces the previous letter of agreement made by LTBB with Wesley L. Andrews on September 19, 1995.
