OJJDP Grant Authorization

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a federally recognized Indian tribe as reaffirmed through Public Law 103-324 of September 21, 1994, as amended;

WHEREAS the Tribe seeks to work with its youth to prevent problems such as substance abuse, alcoholism, truancy, and other crime, and to help rehabilitate youth who are already involved in such unhealthy and dangerous activities;

WHEREAS the Tribal Court, through the development of effective and culturally appropriate juvenile justice and probation systems, can play a crucial role in steering our youth in a positive direction;

WHEREAS the grant monies available through the United States Department of Justice Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP) would enable the Tribal Court to develop a Juvenile Code, Court Rules and a probation system;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, through its Tribal Council, authorizes submission of a grant application to OJJDP, to fund the Tribal Court's development of a Juvenile Code, Court Rules and a probation system;

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman or his designee is authorized to sign any documents necessary to apply for, receive, and administer funds under the grant.
