 WHEREAS effective government-to-government consultation with the United States
- WHEREAS effective government-to-government consultation with the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) will significantly aid in this environmental protection effort;
- WHEREAS in accordance with the Executive Order of the United States President of November 6, 2000 (Executive Order 13175) which requires all federal agencies to consult and coordinate their efforts with Indian tribal governments, the EPA has formed a workgroup consisting EPA personnel and one tribal representative from each of the nine EPA regions;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council appoints LTBB Environmental Services Department Director Taimi Hoag to serve as EPA Region 5 Tribal representative.
