Approval of Tribal/State Accord

- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians (LTBB or Tribe) is a sovereign federally recognized Indian tribe;
- WHEREAS** it is in the Tribe's interest to promote effective government-to-government communication with the State of Michigan in a manner that recognizes and respects the sovereign governmental status of LTBB;
- WHEREAS** on October 28, 2002, the Governor of the State of Michigan and the federally recognized tribes located in Michigan met to execute an accord to improve government-to-government relations for the mutual benefit of the tribes and state;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians approves the 2002 Government-to-Government Accord between the State of Michigan and the Federally Recognized Indian Tribes in the State of Michigan and affirms the execution of that document by Tribal Chairman Gerald V. Chingwa by and on behalf of the Tribe.
