Recognition of 2004 Native Vote Volunteer Tribal Member Committee

WHEREAS American Indians have only had the right to vote in national, state and local elections since passage of Indian Citizenship Act on June 2, 1924;

WHEREAS it is critical that Indians have a voice in national, state and local elections by exercising their voting rights;

WHEREAS a number of LTBB Tribal members worked long and hard on a volunteer basis in the months before the 2004 election and on the day of the election to register Indian voters, encourage Indian people to vote, provide transportation and monitor the election process to insure fairness;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians thanks the 2004 Native Vote Volunteer Tribal Member Committee, Marilyn Williams, Su Lantz, Valerie Biro, Allie Greenleaf Maldonado, and the many community volunteers who assisted in this outstanding job.
