**RESOLUTION 111801-03**

**DESIGNATION of DELEGATE TO THE  
NATIONAL CONGRESS OF AMERICAN INDIANS**

**WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, a federally recognized Indian tribe, reaffirmed by Public Law 103-324, 25 U.S.C. §1300k, is a member of the National Congress of American Indians (NCAI);

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians designates Tribal Chairman Gerald V. Chingwa as NCAI delegate at the NCAI 58<sup>th</sup> Annual Convention and thereby authorizes him to cast votes on the Tribe's behalf.

As Tribal Secretary I certify that this Resolution was duly adopted by the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians at a regular meeting of the Tribal Council held on November 18, 2001 at which a quorum was present, by a vote of 5 in favor, 0 opposed, 1 abstentions, and 1 absent as recorded by this roll call.
