- Tribal Burial Board, Inc. Request for FY2021 Contribution in the Amount of \$44,823.34 to come from the General Fund-Fund Balance restricted for Economic Development
- WHEREAS, The Waganakising Odawak Nation, known as the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, and its citizens are vested with inherent sovereignty and rights of self-governance;
- WHEREAS, The Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States, the most recent of which are the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);
- WHEREAS, The Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is governed by a Tribal Constitution adopted by the Citizens of the Tribe on February 1, 2005;
- WHEREAS, Waganakising Odawak Statute 2020-008 established the Tribal Burial Board;
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Burial Board, Inc. is requesting contribution funding of board stipends; office supplies; rent and utilities; and consultants in the amount \$44,823.34 for fiscal year 2021.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council authorizes the funding for Tribal Burial Board, Inc. in the amount of \$44,823.34 to come from the General Fund-Fund Balance restricted for Economic Development, with the understanding that the Tribal Burial Board, Inc. will repay the funds to the Tribe in accordance with the its charter.

FINALLY, BE IT RESOLVED that the distribution of funding for Tribal Burial Board, Inc. will be made in equal quarterly installment in the amount of \$11,205.83, beginning on January 1, 2021 and following each quarter thereafter.
