

WAGANAKISING ODAWAK STATUTE 1997009
PLUMBING CODE AMENDMENT TO THE BUILDING CODE
ADOPTION ORDINANCE

SECTION I. SHORT TITLE AND PURPOSE

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MINIMUM REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, ALTERATION, ENLARGEMENT, REPAIR, DEMOLITION, REMOVAL, MAINTENANCE AND USE OF ALL BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES WITH REGARD TO PLUMBING SYSTEMS; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS, COLLECTION OF FEES, MAKING OF INSPECTIONS; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS, COLLECTION OF FEES, MAKING OF INSPECTIONS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; KNOWN AS THE PLUMBING CODE; AND REPEALING ANY EXISTING ORDINANCES WHICH MAY REFERENCE PARTS THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians as follows:

SECTION II. ADOPTION OF PLUMBING CODE

That a certain document, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Tribal Planning Department of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, being marked and designated as "The International Plumbing Code, 1995" as published by The Building Officials and Code Administrators International, Inc. be and is hereby adopted as the Plumbing Code of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians; for the control of buildings and structures as herein provided; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions, and terms of said BOCA International Plumbing Code are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this Ordinance, with the additions, insertions, deletions, and changes, if any, prescribed in Section IV of this Ordinance.

SECTION VI. SAVINGS CLAUSE

That nothing in this Ordinance or in the building code hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding impending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed as cited in Section III of this Ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinances.


Certification
