WAGANAKISING ODAWAK STATUTE 2002-04

INDIAN PREFERENCE IN TRIBAL EMPLOYMENT

1 2	SECTION I: PURPOSE						
3	This Statute rescinds and replaces Waganakising Odawak Statute 1998015. This Tribal						
4	Employment Statute is hereby enacted to mandate the preferential employment, promotion and						
5	training of tribal members and other persons by the Tribe and its business enterprises, as						
6	permitted and promoted under federal law based on the unique political relationship between						
7	Indian tribes and the United States.

9	SECTION II: DEFINITIONS						
10							
11	A. "Tribal Business Enterprise" means any business owned, operated or licensed by the						
12	Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians.						
13							
14	B. "Employment Preference" means a preference given to a job applicant or employee in						
15	hiring, promotion and training decisions when choosing qualified applicants or employees.						
16							
17	C. "Qualified applicant" means a person who meets minimum qualifications, experience,						
18	background, abilities or education.						
19							
20	SECTION III: EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES						
21							
22	A. Indian preference. The Tribe and Tribal Business Enterprises shall grant Employment						
23	Preference for hiring, promotion and training to the following persons in the following order:

25	1. Members of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians,

27	2. Other federally recognized members of North American Indian Tribes.

2	B. General. Except for the Indian preference stated in Section III (A), employment,							
3	promotion and training opportunities within the Tribe and Tribal Business Enterprises will be							
4	offered to qualified individuals without regard to race, religion, color, ancestry, gender, age or							
5	national origin.

7	C. Contractors an	d Subcontractor	s. The Tribe a	nd its business e	nterprises may	require		
8	adherence to this Statute when negotiating contracts.
