8	The purpose of this Statute is to establishes an Odawa Historic and Cultural Site Registry where				
9	property sites are identified, designated and cataloged as historical and cultural sites. The				
10	Odawa Historic and Cultural Site Registry helps preserve significant historic and cultural places				
11	by recognizing this irreplaceable heritage while increasing and broaden the public's				
12	understanding and appreciation of cultural and historic places.				
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15	SECTION II. DEFINITIONS

17	A. "LTBB" or "Tribe" means the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians.

19	B. "Reservation" means all lands within the boundaries of the reservations for the Little				
20	Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians as set out in Article I, paragraphs third and fourth of the				
21	Treaty of 1855, 11 Stat. 621, plus any lands set out in Articles Second and Third of the Treaty of				
22	March 28, 1836, 7 Stat. 491, in the event that the 1836 reservation is determined to include lands				
23	which are not included within the 1855 reservation, plus any lands outside of those boundaries				
24	which are now or in the future declared to be Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indian				
25	reservation by the U.S. Department of the Interior.				
2627	C. "Tribal Citizen" means an enrolled member of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of				
28	Odawa Indians.

30	D. "Tribal Council" or "Council" means the elected body of the Little Traverse Bay				
31	Bands of Odawa Indians to carry out legislative powers under Article VII of the Constitution.

33	E. "THPO" or "Office" means the Tribal Historic Preservation Office composed of the

8	SECTION	VIV. DUTIES and AUTHORITY

10	A. The	Office shall have the following duties and authority:

12	1.	To create and maintain an Odawa Historic and Cultural Site Registry that can be

15	2.	To evaluate nominations of sites for inclusion in the Odawa Historic and Cultural			
16	Site	Registry.

18	3.	To consult with Elders, Tribal Citizens and other experts as part of the assessment			
19	process to determine suitability of a nominated site for inclusion in the Odawa Historic				
20	Cult	tural Site Registry.

2	A. The Office shall use the following criteria to determine the suitability of inclusion of a site				
3	in the Odawa Historic and Cultural Site Registry:

5	1.	Significance in Odawa history, architecture, archeology, heritage, religion,			
6	engi	neering or culture.

8	2.	Association with events that have made a significant contribution to the broad			
9	patterns of Odawa history;

11	3.	Association with the lives of significant or historical Odawa persons;

13	4.	Yielded or may be likely to yield, important information in Odawa history.

27	SECTION	VI. SITE REGISTRY

29	A. Upo	n receipt of a nomination of a site, the Office shall determine if site is suitable for			
30	inclusion in the Odawa Historic and Cultural Site Registry.

32	B. The	Odawa Historic and Cultural Site Registry shall contain documentation on each site			
33		rovide a physical description of the place, information about its history or cultural			
34	significance, a bibliography, photographs, and maps, as appropriate.				

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1	SECTION VII.	PRIVATE PROPERTY				
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3	Private property li	sted in the Odawa Historic and Cultural Site Registry does not place any				
4	restrictions or requirements on a private property owner. The private landowner is not required to					
5	maintain the property in any specific way.

8	SECTION VIII.	SEVERABILITY				
9						
10	If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, phrase or portion of this Statute is, for any reason,					
11	held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be					
12	deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity					
13	of the remaining portions thereof.

16	SECTION IX.	EFFECTIVE DATE				
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18	Effective upon signature of the Executive or 30 days from Tribal Council approval whichever					
19	comes first or if the Executive vetoes the legislation, then upon Tribal Council override of the veto.
