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6	SECTION I. PURPOSE AND TITLE				
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8	A. Purpose. The Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians (the "Tribe") exercises				
9	powers of self-government over its Citizens and territory. In accordance with Article VII (D) (4),				
10	the purpose of this Statute is to govern the issuance of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa				
11	Indians charter of incorporation for economic purpose, to provide for the management of the				
12	non-gaming, economic affairs and to delegate such management to a Tribally chartered				
13	corporation in accordance with Article VII (D) (24) and regulate such tribally chartered				
14	corporation activities in accordance with Article VII (D) (4).				
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16	B. Short Title. This Statute shall be known and cited as the "Odawa Construction				
17	Corporation Statute."				
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20	SECTION II. DEFINITIONS

22	A. "Territorial Jurisdiction of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians" means				
23	"areas referenced in Public Law 103-324, 25 USC Section 1300k-2(b)(2)(A) as the boundaries				
24	of the reservations for the Little Traverse Bay Bands as set out in Article I, paragraphs 'third				
25	and fourth' of the Treaty of 1855, 11 Stat.621." Little Traverse Bay Bands Constitution, Article				
26	V(A)(1)(a).

28	B. "Tribe" or "LTBB" means the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians.				
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30	C. "Tribal Constitution" means the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians				
31	Constitution as adopted by its membership on February 1, 2005.				
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1	D. "Tribal Coun	cil" means the elected body of nine (9) Tribal members of Little Traverse				
2	Bay Bands of Odawa Indians with duties found in the Tribal Constitution Article VII. "Tribal					
3	Council".					
4	SECTION III.	CREATION OF THE ODAWA CONSTRUCTION CORPORATE				
5		CHARTER				
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7	A tribally charted corporation is authorized by this Statute and shall be named the "Odaw					
8	Construction, Inc." The organization is recognized by the approval of the tribal corporation					
9	charter; "Odawa Construction, Inc." by Tribal Council.					
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12	SECTION IV.	SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES				
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14	A. The Odawa C	onstruction, Inc. is created as a tribally chartered corporation that promotes				
15	economic self-sufficiency and creates jobs through construction of tribally owned projects or					
16	local projects within t	he community.				
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18	B. The Odawa C	onstruction, Inc. is authorized to create operating subsidiaries in accordance				
19	with tribal law.

21	C. The Corporati	on will provide Tribal Council an annual report and audited financial				
22	statements.

24	D. The Corporati	on will submit an annual development plan to the Tribal Council for				
25	approval.					
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28	SECTION V.	MANAGEMENT, STRUCTURE AND FUNCTION				
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30	A. The Odawa C	construction, Inc. shall have sole authority and responsibility for managing				
31	the Odawa Construct	ion, Inc. and related construction projects, in accordance with the policies,				
32	Statutes, Resolutions,	regulations as approved by Tribal Council.				
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1 2	B. The Odawa Construction, Inc. shall abide by all tribal and federal laws and regulations a may be applicable.				
3 4 5	C.	It is the duty of the Odawa Construction, Inc. to protect assets of the Tribe and generate			
6	revenues and jobs.				
7	D.	The Odawa Construction, Inc. reports to and passes revenue to the Odawa Economic			
8 9	Affairs Holding Corporation.				
10	E.	The management of the corporation shall be conducted by 3 to 7 at will employees titled			
11 12	Business Policy Managers.				
13		a. The majority of the Business Policy Managers must be Tribal Citizens.			
14		b. Business Policy Managers shall be selected by the Odawa Economic Affairs			
15		Holding Corporation.			
16		c. These Business Policy Managers may when deemed necessary recruit up to two			
17 18 19		of the seven persons with special skills needed and they will serve as long as needed by their selectors.			
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21	SECT	ION VI. REPORTING TO TRIBAL COUNCIL			
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23	In order to regulate, the Odawa Construction, Inc. shall provide to Tribal Council a monthly				
24	report for the Corporation and all subsidiaries; and shall report quarterly at the regularly				
25	scheduled Tribal Council Meetings or such special meetings as requested by the Tribal Council,				
26	or as requested the following:				
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28	A.	Annual operating plan;			
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30	В.	Financial performance measures;			
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32	C.	Audits, whether internal or external;			
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3435	D.	Financial records or statements;			

1 2	E.	Tribal Council may request reports regarding all aspects of the Odawa Construction, Inc.;			
3	F.	Monthly profit and loss statement of all non-gaming enterprises, joint ventures and			
4	investments.				
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7	SECTION VII. FINANCING OF THE ODAWA CONSTRUCTION, INC. AND				
8	ACTIVITIES				
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10	A.	The annual budget for the Odawa Construction, Inc. shall be approved by Tribal Council			
11	in accordance with an approval process as designated by the Tribal Council.				
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13	В.	Tribal Council approval is required for borrowing of funds. The Odawa Construction,			
14	Inc. is	s not authorized to enter into financing approval without prior ratification by the Tribal			
15	Counc	zil.			
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18	SECT	TION VIII. SAVING CLAUSE			
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20		In the event that any phrase, provision, part, paragraph, subsection or section of this			
21	statute	e is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to violate the Constitution, laws, ordinances			
22	or stat	tutes of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, such phrase, provision, part,			
23	paragr	raph, subsection or section shall be considered to stand alone and to be deleted from this			
24	statute	e, the entirety of the balance of the statute to remain in full and binding force and effect.			
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27	SECT	TION IX. EFFECTIVE DATE			
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29	Effect	ive upon signature of the Executive or thirty (30) days from Tribal Council approval			
30	which	ever comes first or if the Executive vetoes the legislation, then upon Tribal Council			
31	override of the veto.
