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     SECTION XIV.
                           SAVINGS CLAUSE
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     In the event that any phrase, provision, part, paragraph, subsection or section of this statute is found
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     by a court of competent jurisdiction to violate the Constitution, laws or ordinances of the Little
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     Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, such phrase, provision, part, paragraph, subsection or
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     section shall be considered to stand alone and to be deleted from this statute, the entirety of the
     balance of the statute to remain in full and binding force and effect.
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     SECTION XV.
                           EFFECTIVE DATE
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     Effective upon signature of the Executive or shall be deemed enacted if not expressly vetoed by
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     the Executive within thirty (30) days of submission. The Tribal Council may, by an affirmative
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     vote of seven (7) members of the Tribal Council, override a veto by the Executive.
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
