7	I. INSERT TO SECTION V. RIGHTS OF CRIME VICTIMS

9	L. Right to Confidentiality. All statements and information given by a victim of
10	domestic violence or sexual assault to any victim advocate, therapist or counselor shall be
11	deemed confidential, and shall not be admissible in court, absent a waiver of said
12	confidentiality by the victim, or except as otherwise authorized by law or pursuant to
13	court order. A therapist or counselor is a licensed individual with at least a bachelor's
14	degree in counseling, psychology, social work or other related fields who is providing
15	professional counseling, therapy or psychological services to a victim of domestic or
16	sexual violence, whether paid or volunteer. A victim advocate is a professional
17	individual trained and working in an office to provide information, emotional support, or
18	assistance with community resources, be it financial, legal, therapeutic, or otherwise in
19	order to help victims of domestic or sexual violence.

22	SECTION II. EFFECTIVE DATE
23	
24	Effective upon signature of the Executive or thirty (30) days from Tribal Council approval
25	whichever comes first or if the Executive vetoes the legislation, then upon Tribal Council
26	override of the veto.
