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7	The purpose of this Statute is to layout the guidelines for the Little Traverse Bay Bands (LTBB)				
8	of Odawa Indians Department of Human Services to distribute allocated funds for allowance of				
9	health, food and housing to Tribal Citizens who participate in the Health, Food and Housing				
10	Program. Hereinafter the Health, Food and Housing Program will be referred to as "HFH". HFH				
11	will be in accordance with the "IRS Tribal General Welfare Guidance" and the "General Welfare				
12	Statute."

15	SECTION II. GENERAL WELFARE EXCLUSION

17	As stated by the requirements of the United States Internal Revenue Section 139E, Health, Food				
18	and Housing Program meets the criteria of the United States Public Law 113-168, Tribal General				
19	Welfare Exclusion Act of 2014 and WOS 2017-002 General Welfare Statute.

24	A. "Department" means the Department of Human Services.

Application shall be made available upon request from a LTBB Citizen or a 19 Parent/Guardian of a minor dependent LTBB Citizen that applies. 20 21 D. The Department will publish the application, no later than the June issue, in the Odawa 22 Newsletter of the current calendar year. An updated version of the program's application will be 23 posted on the LTBB website by the Department of Human Services, no later than June 1st of the 24 current calendar year. 25 26 Ε. Applications shall be deemed completed if they contain the following information: 27 28 1. Name and contact information; 29 30 2. Enrollment number; 31 32 3. Dated signature of the LTBB Citizen or a Parent/Guardian of a minor 33 dependent LTBB Citizen that applies applying for the program certifying that the 34 funds will be used toward health, food or housing expenditures.
