TRIBAL RESOLUTION # 062421- () AD-HOC ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION GRANT COMMITTEE

- WHEREAS the Waganakising Odawak Nation, known as the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians (LTBB), and its citizens are vested with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance;
- WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);
- WHEREAS the United States, Economic Development Administration (EDA), a bureau within the Department of Commerce, provides grants to Indian Tribes to facilitate the development, implementation, revision, or replacement of Comprehensive Economic Development Strategies (CEDS), which articulate and prioritize the strategic economic goals of recipients' respective regions;
- WHEREAS the EDA awards eligible recipients grants for short-term planning that creates and implements regional economic development plans designed to build capacity and guides the economic prosperity and resiliency of an area or region;
- WHEREAS the best method to develop and submit a grant to the EDA is to utilize an ad-hoc committee;
- WHEREAS the ad-hoc committee will meet with stakeholders, Directors, Executive staff and other entities in order to gather information for the development of the grant application.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council approves the creation of the Adhoc Economic Development Administration Grant Committee that is comprised of the Planning Director, Grant writers, Unit I Executive Director, Chief Financial Officer, Vice-Chairperson,



GIS Director, Department of Commerce Director, Senior Financial Analyst and two Tribal Councilors.

THEREFORE, FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the Committee will meet as necessary in order to develop the grant application.

FINALLY, BE IT RESOLVED the Committee shall automatically dissolve upon the submission of the Economic Development Administration (EDA) grant for short-term planning to the United States Department of Commerce.
