Appendix 1. Draft Primary/Designated Uses and Definitions*

Warm water Fishery (WF) - Warm water fisheries support fish able to tolerate monthly water temperatures not above 83F/28.3. Waters which support or are managed for populations of warm water game fishes and lack significant populations of salmonid fishes.

Warm water Fishery with principal migratory routes for anadromous salmonids (WFMAS) - Waters which will support populations of salmon and trout spawning in rivers, creeks, or streams to spawn.

Coldwater Fishery (CF) - Support fish that prefer clear, cold waters; are not tolerant of extreme temperature or dissolved oxygen changes.

Primary Contact Recreational (PCR) - means any activities involving direct contact with water to the point of complete submergence, particularly immersion of the head, with considerable risk of ingesting water, including swimming.

Partial/Secondary Contact Recreational (PSCR)- means any activities involving direct contact of some part of the body with water, but not normally involving immersion of the head or ingestion water, including fishing, wading, hunting, and dry boating.

Public Water Source Supply (PWS) - surface waters that are used as a source of drinking water.

Indigenous aquatic life and wildlife (IAW)- supporting a population of aquatic life originating in and naturally living, growing, or occurring in a particular water body or wildlife populations that utilize the water body for subsistence, sustained growth and propagation.

Subsistence Fishery (SF)-waters fished by indigenous people of the geographical area to provide food for their families and community as done for generations.

Wild Rice Areas (WRA)-A stream, river, lake, or impoundment, or portion thereof, presently has or historically had the potential to sustain the growth of wild rice (also known as Zizania palustris or manoomin) for either wildlife or human subsistence.

Cultural/ ceremonial uses (CU) - any waters that support cultural uses and ceremonies practiced by indigenous people of the geographical area.

Navigation Uses (NU) - Water is used for the transfer (via boats) of persons, animals, and goods for commercial and/or industrial purposes.
