**RESOLUTION 052100-01
PROTECTION OF GRAY WOLF AND ALL ENDANGERED SPECIES**

WHEREAS, the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians (LTBB or Tribe) is a federally recognized tribe and the Tribal Council of LTBB is the governing body of the Tribe;

WHEREAS, in the Treaty Washington of 1836 (7 Stat. 491) LTBB reserved rights to preserve, conserve and protect the natural resources within its reservation and throughout the lands and waters ceded in that Treaty;

WHEREAS, the LTBB Natural Resources Department participates in the Northern Michigan Wolf Detection and Habitat Survey Team which conducts research to identify and protect the Gray Wolf, an endangered specie, on the LTBB Reservation and 1836 Treaty ceded lands and waters;

WHEREAS, future research work within the LTBB Natural Resources Department is warranted to further document and identify endangered species utilizing the habitat of the LTBB Reservation and 1836 Treaty ceded lands and waters;


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians supports the protection of the Gray Wolf and all known endangered species inhabiting the LTBB Reservation and 1836 Treaty ceded lands and waters, and encourages the LTBB Natural Resources Department to continue its efforts to document and identify these species to foster their preservation.
