## Executive Directive #48-01312022-01 Extension of Hazard Duty Pay for Health Department Staff

The Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians (LTBB) Tribal Constitution, adopted February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2005, establishes the Executive Branch of the Tribal Government and the Tribal Chairperson as the elected official who exercises Executive Authority under the Constitution.

Article VIII, Section C, Paragraph 5 places the following responsibility on the Tribal Chairperson: "To oversee all Tribal Executive departments, boards, commissions and committees created by Tribal Council."

The Tribal Chairperson signed Executive Directive #41 which approved hazard pay for Health Department staff involved with direct contact to provide services to citizens and LTBB essential front-line health employees that had direct contact with outside persons.

The Executive wishes to extend the hazard pay for Health Department staff from January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022 until February 12<sup>th</sup>, 2022. All Health Department staff, including exempt and non-exempt, who work on-site shall receive additional hazard pay in the amount of \$10.00 per hour. Hazard pay does not apply to hours utilized for PTO and/or any leave provided by LTBB.

This timeframe may be extended subsequent Executive Directive(s).

This Executive Directive becomes effective January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022, Executive Directive 48-01312022-01, and remains in effect until February 12<sup>th</sup>, 2022.
