- Supplemental Funding for the Natural Resource Department for Purchase of Land Parcel #149 in the amount of \$224,546.17 to come from General Fund-Fund Balance
- WHEREAS the Waganakising Odawak Nation, known as the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, and its citizens are vested with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance;
- WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);
- WHEREAS the Natural Resources Department has submitted a potential land parcel #149 to the Land and Reservation Committee for consideration of purchasing;
- WHEREAS Land Parcel #149 would provide access sites on the Great Lakes suitable for exercising Treaty fishing rights;
- **WHEREAS** the total cost of Land Parcel #149, along with closing cost, land improvements/building demolition, is estimated at \$360,000.00;
- WHEREAS the Natural Resources Department has funding through the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) COVID-19 Fishermen Relief to purchase access sites on the Great Lakes suitable for exercising Treaty fishing rights;
- WHEREAS National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) COVID-19
 Fishermen Relief fund has \$135,453.83 available to goes toward the purchase of Land Parcel #149, leaving a remaining balance of \$224,546.17 to complete the purchase and improvements to the land parcel.

THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tribal Council appropriates the sum of \$224,546.17 to come from the General Fund-Fund Balance, and these funds are restriction for the sole purpose of purchasing Land Parcel #149, along with closing cost, land improvements/building demolition, and shall be not be used for any other purpose.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that in accordance with the Constitution the Executive Branch shall administer such funds as appropriated by Tribal Council.
