Governmental Branch Allocation of General Funds for Fiscal Year 2023

- WHEREAS The Waganakising Odawak Nation, known as the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, and its citizens are vested with inherent sovereignty and rights of self-governance; and
- WHEREAS The Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States, the most recent of which are the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621); and
- **WHEREAS** The Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is governed by a Tribal Constitution adopted by the Citizens of the Tribe on February 1, 2005;
- WHEREAS in accordance with the Constitution, Tribal Council enacted a Budget Formulation Statute, WOS 2015-016 "Tribal Government Budget Formulation and Modification Statue;
- **WHEREAS** according to WOS 2015-016, by February 15th of the prior fiscal year, Tribal Council shall approve the Governmental Branches allocation amount of general funds that each branch of government may utilize for their base budget for the following year;
- **WHEREAS** the anticipated General Fund Revenue for Fiscal Year 2023 is approximately \$13,765,000; and the allocated amounts of general funds are based on anticipated revenues, anticipated outlays, available funds and historical numbers for the last three years of actual spending by Governmental Branches.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Governmental Branches allocation of the general

funds is as follows: Legislative \$1,348,000; Judicial \$1,275,000; Prosecutor \$300,000; Election Board \$135,000; Executive \$10,100,000 for a total amount of \$13,158,000. All remaining revenues will be allocated to the General Fund – Fund Balance.
