TRIBAL RESOLUTION # 072723- <u>02</u>

Supplemental Funding in the amount of \$997,619 for FY 2023 to implement the LTBB Elder Vision Care Program to come from Third Party Revenue generated by the LTBB Health Department

- WHEREAS, the Waganakising Odawak Nation, known as the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, and its citizens are vested with inherent sovereignty and rights of self-governance; and
- WHEREAS, the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States, the most recent of which are the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621); and
- WHEREAS, the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is governed by a Tribal Constitution adopted by the citizens of the Tribe on February 1, 2005; and
- WHEREAS, Tribal Council authorizes and appropriates budgets through Tribal Resolutions; and
- WHEREAS, the Health Department has been tasked with creating the LTBB Elder Vision Care Program to assist all Tribal Elders;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council authorizes and approves additional funds that are needed to implement the Elder Vision Care Program for the remainder of FY 2023 in the amount of \$997,619 from Third Party Revenue generated by the LTBB Health Department. The program will be included in future budgets and will continue as long as funding is available to support the program.

FINALLY, BE IT RESOLVED that in accordance with the Constitution, the Executive Branch shall administer such funds as appropriated by Tribal Council.
