3	JURISDICTIONAL ADJUSTMENT STATUTE

6	SECTION I. PURPOSE
7	
8	The purpose of this statute is to adjust the territorial jurisdictional of the Little Traverse Bay
9	Bands of Odawa Indians in multiple Tribal laws in response to Little Traverse Bay Bands of
10	Odawa Indians v. Whitmer, 998 F.3d 269, 272 (6th Cir. 2021), cert. denied, 212 L. Ed. 2d 215,
11	142 S. Ct. 1206 (2022). In this case, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit affirmed the
12	district court's determination that the 1855 Treaty of Detroit did not create a reservation for the
13	Tribe under federal law. Although this decision substantially diminishes the Tribe's legal
14	jurisdiction over the lands within the Tribe's 1855 reservation, this region has always been and
15	remains our home.

5	Jurisdiction of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians" means all land that is held in
6	trust by the United States government for the benefit of the Tribe.

9	SECTION III. SAVINGS CLAUSE
10	
11	In the event that any phrase, provision, part, paragraph, subsection or section of this statute is
12	found by a court of competent jurisdiction to violate the Constitution or laws of LTBB, such
13	phrase, provision, part, paragraph, subsection or section shall be considered to stand alone and to
14	be deleted from this statute, the entirety of the balance of the statute to remain in full and binding
15	force and effect.

18	SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE
19	
20	This statute shall be effective upon the signature of the Executive, or 30 days from Tribal
21	Council approval, or if the Executive vetoes the legislation, then upon the date on which Tribal
22	Council overrides the veto.
