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4	SECTION I. PURPOSE				
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6	The purpose of this statute is to establish a standard requirement for financial disclosure statement				
7	by elected and appointed officials, as well as candidates for such positions, as required by Article				
8	XV.B of the Constitution of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians. This statute repeals				
9	and replaces Waganakising Odawak Statute 2016-003 and 2006-023.				
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12	SECTION II. DEFINITIONS				
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14	A. "Branch Office" means the primary office of the Legislative, Executive, or Judicial				
15	branch of the Tribe.				
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17	B. "Candidate" means any person who runs for a position as an Elected Official, is				
18	nominated for an appointment as a Judiciary Official or is nominated for an appointment to a				
19	governmental commission, board or committee.				
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21	C. "Elected Official" means the Tribal Chair, Vice Chair and Tribal Councilors.				
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23	D. "Immediate Family" means husband, wife, son, daughter, step-son, step-daughter, father				
24	step-father, father-in-law, mother, step-mother, mother-in-law, brother, step-brother, brother-in-				
25	law, sister, step-sister, sister-in-law, child, step-child, son-in-law, daughter-in-law or a person				
26	whose relationship with the Tribal Citizen is similar to that of persons who are related by blood				
27	or marriage.

29	E. "Judiciary Official" means a Judge or Justice of the Tribal Court.				
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31	F. "Personal Financial Interest" means a financial interest benefiting an elected or appointed				
32	governmental official, a candidate, or an immediate family member of a candidate or				
33	governmental official.				
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35	G. "Tribal Citizen" means an enrolled member of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa				
36	Indians.

26	disclosures to their Branch Office within 30 days of any material change to the financial					
27	disclosures submitted as a candidate.

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32	Financial disclosures required by this statute shall be available to Tribal Citizens in accordance					
33	with the Public Documents Statute.					
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36	SECT	TION V	II. SEVERABILITY			

1	If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, phrase or portion of this Statute is, for any				
2	reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall				
3	be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the				
4	validity of the remaining portions thereof.				
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7	SECTION VIII. EFFECTIVE DATE				
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9	This statute shall be effective upon the signature of the Executive, or 30 days from Tribal				
10	Council approval, or if the Executive vetoes the legislation, then upon the date on which Tribal				
11	Council overrides the veto.
