Budget Modification for FY 2024 in the amount of \$196,600.80 to create a
Community Health Case Manager and Community Health Navigator within the
Health Department to come from Third Party Revenue, AOA Workforce Grant,
and Community Health Funds

- WHEREAS, the Waganakising Odawak Nation, known as the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, and its citizens are vested with inherent sovereignty and rights of self-governance; and
- WHEREAS, the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States, the most recent of which are the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621); and
- WHEREAS, the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is governed by a Tribal Constitution adopted by the citizens of the Tribe on February 1, 2005; and
- WHEREAS, Tribal Council authorizes and appropriates budgets through Tribal Resolutions; and

WHEREAS, the LTBB Health Department provides case managers to oversee Tribal Citizen cases and is moving forward to include specific oversight of vulnerable adults;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council authorizes and approves the transfer of funds that are needed to support the Community Health Case Manager and Community Health Navigator for FY 2024 in the amount of \$196,600.80 to come from the Third-Party Revenue, AOA Workforce Grant, and Community Health Funds

FINALLY, BE IT RESOLVED that in accordance with the Constitution, the Executive Branch shall administer such funds as appropriated by Tribal Council.
