ODAWA HOMECOMING POW WOW VENDOR RULES AUGUST 10 and 11, 2024

- 1. Vendors are responsible for keeping their area clean and free from trash and obstacles which could result in injuries. **NO ACCUMULATION OF TRASH.**
- 2. Vehicles may be used to transport supplies/goods to assigned vendor space and then moved to a designated parking space set aside for vendors in parking lot.
- 3. Vendor spaces -20 feet width. No exceptions.
- 4. All electrical cords shall be secured, so as to prevent any injuries resulting from their use.
- 5. Any vendor using electricity who did not request electrical service on their vendor application shall pay the full \$25 fee.
- 6. ALL FEES SHALL BE PAID IN ADVANCE.
- 7. **ABSOLUTELY NO DRUGS, ALCOHOL OR FIREARMS** permitted on Pow Wow grounds. ALL VIOLATORS WILL BE REMOVED.
- 8. **Do not block fire emergency entrance!** Keep entrance to grounds clear at all times.
- 9. **No dogs allowed!** Seeing eye dogs are the only dogs permitted on Pow Wow grounds.
- 10. If your booth is a trailer, you will be permitted to park your trailer on grass, but your vehicle will then have to be moved to the parking lot.
- 11. Sweet grass in bundles or braids will be prohibited for sale unless incorporated into traditional craft. This is in accordance with Section 7.07 of the Waganakising Odawak Statute 19970115 as amended on 3/18/2001.
- 12. **The use of plastic straws is prohibited.** This is in accordance with LTBB Tribal Resolution #061021-02 as enacted on 7/14/2021.

ANY VIOLATOR OF ANY OF THE ABOVE RULES WILL BE REQUIRED TO VACATE THE POW WOW GROUNDS. NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED.
