**AMENDMENT TO WAGANAKISING ODAWAK STATUTE 2008-005
TRIBAL NOTARY PUBLIC**

The Section XII of WOS 2008-005 Tribal Notary Public is repealed:

SECTION XII. PROHIBITION ON FOREIGN JURISDICTIONS

Employees of the LTBB are prohibited from performing foreign jurisdiction (other States or Tribal) Notarial acts in conjunction with their employment with LTBB beyond 180 days after the enactment of this Statute.

And Replaced with:

SECTION XII. PROHIBITION ON FOREIGN JURISDICTIONS

Employees of the LTBB are prohibited from performing foreign jurisdiction (other States or Tribal) Notarial acts in conjunction with their employment with LTBB beyond 360 days after the enactment of this Statute.

CERTIFICATION
