WAGANAKISING ODAWAK STATUTE 20214-XXX001 TRIBAL TREASURER RESPONSIBILITIES

SECTION I. PURPOSE

This <u>s</u>Statute is <u>hereby</u> enacted to define the Tribal Council Treasurer's responsibilities <u>and reporting that</u> are <u>explicitly enumerated in the Constitution, consistent with Article VII(c)-(3) of the Constitution of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians.</u> This Statute repeals and replaces WOS 2005 014, 2009 002 and 2010 0032014-001.

SECTION II. DEFINITIONS

- A. The "Tribe" shall means the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians.
- **B.** "Treasurer" means the Tribal Council Treasurer.

SECTION III. CONSTITUTIONAL DUTIES OF THE TREASURER

In addition to performing the duties enumerated by Article VII(c)(3) of the Constitution of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, the Treasurer shall:

The Treasurer shall Article VIIC (3): "submit an annual report, prepared by the accounting department, to the Tribal Membership at its annual meeting. This report shall include all funds received by the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians or through Tribal enterprises. This report shall include all appropriations of the operating funds and Tribal enterprises by department showing how the funds were spent and to include profit and loss statements where applicable."

1. Be required to acquire a surety bond in the amount necessary to cover funds that may be accessible to individual authorized signers.

SECTION IV. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

- A. The Treasurer shall mMake available a quarterly report, prepared in collaboration by the Accounting Office and Office of Finance and Revenue, that contains the following information:
- All funds received by the Tribal Government and all Tribal Enterprises;

SECTION V. OTHER DUTIES REQUIRED BY THE TRIBAL COUNCIL

This Statute hereby establishes the Tribal Council Appropriations and Finance Standing Committee

The Committee shall:

- Consist of three Tribal Council Members assigned by motion, and majority vote at a regularly scheduled Tribal Council meeting and;
- Be chaired by the Tribal Treasurer and;
- Have authority to review all the Tribe's accounts including but not limited to Enterprises and Tribally owned corporations and;
- All requests and responses for information shall be forwarded to all Tribal Council Members and;
- All committee members shall be compensated in accordance with the Tribal Council's stipend policy for attendance at meetings that are scheduled in advance and advertised and;
- The Committee shall report to the full Tribal Council through the Treasurer's report.
