## TRIBAL RESOLUTION # 091224-05

## Appropriation from the General Fund – Fund Balance in the Amount of \$48,782 to Terminate Software-as-a-Service Agreement

- WHEREAS the Waganakising Odawak, known in English as Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians ("LTBB" or "Tribe"), is a federally recognized Indian Tribe with inherent sovereignty and the right to self-governance;
- WHEREAS the LTBB is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States, the most recent of which are the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621) and the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491);
- WHEREAS on September 21, 1994, the LTBB's nation-to-nation relationship with the Federal Government was reaffirmed by the enactment of Public Law 103-324;
- WHEREAS on February 1, 2005, the LTBB Citizenship duly adopted the Tribal Constitution, which vests the Tribal Council with the Tribe's legislative authority and the Tribal Chairperson and Vice Chairperson, who oversee all Tribal Executive Departments, with the Tribe's executive authority;
- **WHEREAS** the Tribe in November 2021 entered into a five-year software-as-a-service agreement with Tyler Technologies and desires to terminate the agreement;
- WHEREAS the Tribe and Tyler have negotiated the basic parameters of an agreement to terminate the four years remaining on the agreement in exchange for a payment of \$48,782.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes and approves an allocation from the General Fund – Fund Balance in the amount of \$48,782 for the purpose of terminating the software-as-a-service agreement with Tyler Technologies.
